

Family Income Form

Dear Parent or Guardian:

The amount of federal funds our school receives depends on the return of this completed form. These funds pay for additional educational services for students who are failing or at risk of failing to meet the same high standards as everyone else in the school.

These federal funds for additional educational services are known as Title I funds. The Akron Public School District provides additional tutoring in reading and mathematics. The Title I law requires that funds be given to schools based on the number of children from low-income families who live in the public school district attendance area.

While the amount of money each school receives depends on the number of children from low-income families, the tutoring services are based on the academic need of the students, regardless of income level.

What happens if you fill out this form?

- Your name will not be given out. Your name and your child's name are NOT required on the form.
- Our school may be able to get more money.
- That money may be used to provide additional intervention services to eligible students and buy materials.
- Your child or other children may get extra help with reading and mathematics.
